





Periodontal Prognosis: To Extract or Not?

How accurate are we at determining the prognosis of periodontally compromised teeth? Are we too hasty in making decisions to extract? This lecture will test your optimism/pessimism towards periodontally compromised teeth. The management of different clinical scenarios will be presented including advanced periodontal disease, endo-perio lesions and furcation involvement. The management of different cases will be supported by current literature.

Dr Ahmed Saleh graduated from the School of Dentistry with honours in 2002. He completed the Australian Dental Council registration and moved to Australia in 2008. Ahmed practiced general dentistry for 10 years in a number of practices in both Cairo and Perth before commencing his post-
