The practise of dentistry is complex and hundreds of decisions, both large and small have to be made every day. Mark maintains a busy Specialist Endodontic practice in Melbourne's CBD and was appointed Clinical Associate Professor of Endodontics at the Melbourne Dental School, University of Melbourne in 2016.
